## University Diploma: French as a Foreign Language Preparation for Graduate Studies (DU FLEPES)

### TRAINING AIMS

The University Diploma "French as a Foreign Language Preparation for Graduate Studies" (FLEPES) enables foreign students to follow a university course in France with efficiency and success.

It was created by the University of Artois to help students to integrate the French university system and give them every opportunity to adapt to different courses and working methods needed for successful studying in France.

### GOALS

- French Language Certification (B2 level for the 1st degree, C1 level for the 2nd degree)
- Acquisition of the level needed to integrate any university course (C1 for Arts departments, B2 for other departments)
- A guarantee to success in studying through a methodological preparation specific to any curriculum

### WHAT OPPORTUNITIES AFTER GRADUATION?

After graduation, the student will integrate the courses of the University of Artois.

Once the diploma is obtained, the student can integrate one of the courses of the University of Artois. He/she will have followed a specific training course allowing him/her to acquire all the necessary skills to succeed.

### TRAINING CONTENT

- Courses developed from real situations of student life and university studies
- Written and oral skills for academic methodology, grammar, vocabulary and culture, skills which are necessary to succeed in the curriculum intended
- General and specialized courses according to their specialities
- Varied courses material: written and oral extracts, wordings, assessed papers, scientific and arts texts, recorded situations of student life, manuals
- Diversified educational equipment and devices: lectures, individual tutoring, group work, free access to computer rooms, use of medias, interactive whiteboards...

## ORGANIZATION

- Specialist teachers in the teaching of French as a Foreign Language
- Groups of 15 to 20 students
- Individual courses with tutoring
- Two assessments in language (January and April) and the final diploma (late June) attesting successful completion of the course and the acquisition of a sufficient level in French to integrate the curriculum intended

<p>440 hours of lessons + 60 hours of personal work with tutoring Approximately 10 hours per week</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Situations in student life (80 h): registration, catering, sports, culture, health, housing ...</li><li>• Understanding of lectures and tutorials (120 h)</li><li>• Oral (40 h): methods of presentation of a dissertation, speech, debate ..</li><li>• Written (120 h): note taking, written assignments specific to departments ...</li><li>• Reading (80 h): scientific texts, subjects, courses ...</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 620 hours of lessons + 80 hours of personal work with tutoring Approximately 20 hours per week</li><li>• The program of the second degree is based on the same structure as the first degree program, with predominance of the humanities, the language skills are more extensive</li><li>• Situations in student life (80 hours)</li><li>• Understanding of lectures and tutorials (170 h)</li><li>• Oral production (90 h)</li><li>• Written production (170 h)</li><li>• Reading (110 h)</li></ul>

## TERMS OF ACCESS

- Being enrolled in a Bachelor or a Master in the native country
- Provisional enrollment in a course in the University of Artois
- Being able to attest the current required level in French (TEF, TCF, DELF)
- Students from outside the EU have to follow the 'Etudes en France' procedure
- Fees (excluding French social security):
  - 1st degree: € 2700
  - 2nd degree: € 3200
